TREE PLANTING

NB: All trees should be full and well shaped, bark unmarked and have healthy root systems

SHRUB, PERENNIAL AND GROUND COVER

NB: Shrubs shall be bushy, well established nursery stock with a good fibrous root system. They shall be container grown, true to size, name and description as scheduled. Shrubs shall conform to appropriate British Standards. Plants shall not be pot bound, nor with roots damaged or restricted. Herbaceous plants shall be supplied as well rooted clumps, showing several healthy buds, and grown in pots. Pots shall be appropriate to the size of the plant supplied. Planted in same species swaths amongst shrub structure planting

Used along building foundations, for balcony screening, on podium level, and in open planting areas
